## **RED DELICIOUS**

These popular apples have earned their name and their reputation. Sweet and Favorful with 11 to 15 percent sugar, Delicious apples have a taste and crisp juicy texture that is familiar to everyone.

With their distinct strawberry shape and deep red color, Delicious apples are easy to identify and hard to miss. California Delicious apples are harvested in late August, can generally be found in the market in fall and early winter, and are known for their sweet taste.

Jesse Hiatt discovered the Red Delicious chance seedling on his farm near Peru, Iowa. As it was growing out of place with the row of Yellow Bellflower apple trees, he tried chopping it down twice. After it sprouted a third time, he decided to let it grow. The fruit was first displayed as the Hawkeye variety at an 1893 fruit show in Louisiana, Missouri. It was later renamed Delicious but is best known as Red Delicious to distinguish it from the Golden Delicious.

## **JONATHAN**

Farmer Phillip Rick first discovered Jonathan as a chance seedling in Woodstock, New York in 1800. It is a beautiful brilliant red apple of excellent fragrance and flavor. The apple was originally known as the Rick apple, but later named Jonathan after Jonathan Hasbrouk who first focused horticultural attention to it in 1826. It is believed that the Esopus Spitzenburg is one parent of the Jonathan with the other unknown. Jonathan apples are available from California from late August through November.

## **GOLDEN DELICIOUS**

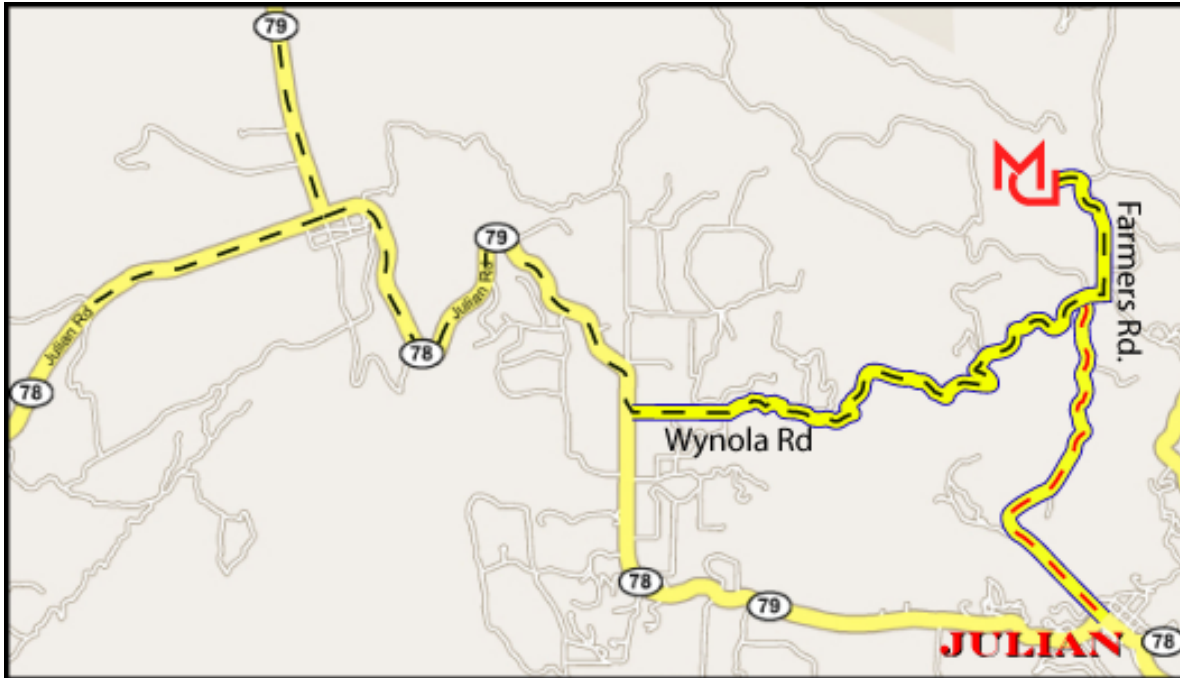
With their distinct strawberry shape and golden yellow color, Delicious apples are easy to identify and hard to miss. California Delicious apples are harvested in late August, can generally be found in the market in fall and early winter, and are known for their sweet taste.

Golden Delicious was discovered as a chance seedling in Clay County, West Virginia in 1914. It was named Mullin's Yellow Seedling to later be changed to Golden Delicious by Stark Brothers as a companion to Red Delicious. The parentage of Golden Delicious is thought to be Golden Reinette and Grimes Golden.

### **Driving Directions**

**From San Diego use black dashed line:**

Head to Ramona, either by using CA Hwy-67 or from North County using CA Hwy-78  
Once in Ramona you will continue through town heading out on CA-78 towards Julian.  
You will pass through Santa Ysabal continue on CA-78

Upon entering Wynola you will take a Left on to Wynola Road, Wynola Road is across from The Wynola Pizza Express Restaurant (Great Pizza)

Go up Wynola Road for about 3.5 miles to the continuation of Farmers Road, which will be on your Left (look for our MJ Ranch sign.)

Take a Left onto Farmers Road and continue down for .5 miles to our sign on your Left then head up the driveway continuing over the hill to the MJ Ranch and Orchard U-Pick.

**From the town of Julian use red dashed line:**

At the four-way stop sign in the beginning of town head North East out of town on Main Street past the Fire station.  
At the Fire Station the Main Street becomes Farmers Road. Continue on for roughly 2.5 miles to the stop sign you should see our sign.

Take a right and go down about 100 yards then left there should be a MJ Ranch sign pointing Left down the continuation of Farmers Road.

About ¼ mile down on the left you will see the entrance to MJ Ranch and Orchard sign again.

That the Left then head up the driveway continuing over the hill to the MJ Ranch and Orchard U-Pick.

**From Los Angeles / Orange County use black dashed line:**

Travel 5 South to CA Hwy-78 East and follow these directions (also good for San Diego residents traveling East on CA Hwy-78):

From Hwy 78: Take 78 East (it starts as a freeway, goes through Escondido and turns into a rural 2-lane highway)

You will drive past the San Diego Wild Animal Park

Keep going through the Avacado groves up the grade to Ramona

When you arrive in Ramona, go left at the light (still CA Hwy-78)

You will pass through Santa Ysabal continue on CA Hwy-78

Upon entering Wynola you will take a Left on to Wynola Road, Wynola Road is across from The Wynola Pizza Express Restaurant (Great Pizza)

Go up Wynola Road for about 3.5 miles to the continuation of Farmers Road, which will be on your Left (look for our MJ Ranch sign.)

Take a Left onto Farmers Road and continue down for .5 miles to our sign on the Left then head up the driveway continuing over the hill to the MJ Ranch and Orchard U-Pick.
